### Jacksonville's Historic Cemetery Stroll

It's not too late to volunteer for the Second Annual Jacksonville Historic Cemetery Stroll, coming in October! Leading up to Alabama's bicentennial in 2019, the stroll is an event to celebrate local history and "discover" the lives of featured past Jacksonvillians.

On Saturday, July 21<sup>st</sup> at 10am at the library, we will review the list of interred persons to be featured this year and ask for volunteer portrayals; this will be the last volunteer meeting before a dress rehearsal in September. If you are a descendant of a person buried in the cemetery, we urge you to be a part of this event to tell their story; they do not have to be a founding father or mother – everyone helped make the Jacksonville we know & love today!

If you don't have direct ancestors or other relatives buried in the city cemetery, there are other volunteer opportunities at the stroll.
