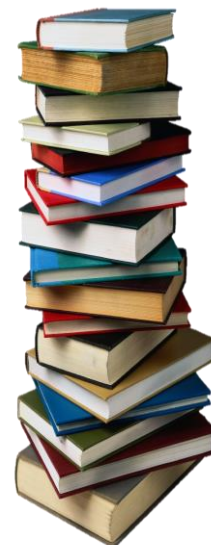

# NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH

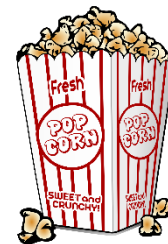

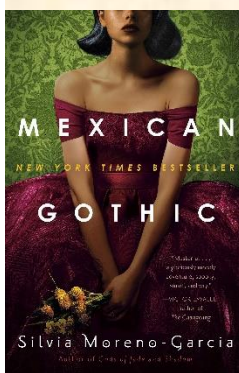

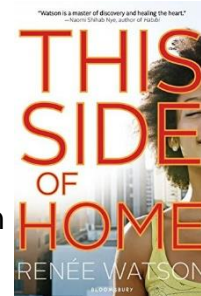
