IF CARD HOLDER IS A MINOR:

Minors (ages 0-18) must have a parent/legal guardian's permission to use library services; however, Jacksonville Public Library realizes in some cases minors ages 16-18 may be in the library without an adult caregiver, or in the case of younger teens (ages 13-15), inside while the caregiver waits in a vehicle. Therefore, as the parent/legal guardian of the minor card holder, you may grant permission for them to access library services without you present.

- check out any item from the Children's Collection including all board books, picture books and read along kits.
- check out any item from the Juvenile Collection including all chapter books, youth biographies & non-fiction, audiobooks and graphic novels rated E or EA for everyone.
- check out any item from the Young Adult Collection in the Teen Room including graphic novels rated for ages 10+ (Y) or 13+ (T)
- check out any item from the Adult Collection including fiction, non-fiction, biographies, audiobooks and graphic novels that are rated OT (16+) or M (19+).
- use the Library's internet connected computers.
Please note: the library's free wi-fi is available to any internet capable device, and while the network is protected by Child Internet Protection Act compliant internet filters, Library staff are unable to monitor what is accessed using a personal device.

If none of the options are selected, a parent/legal guardian or other responsible adult caregiver age 19 or older will have to be present for a minor (ages 0-18) to access to these library services regardless of age.
